Day 66: Compensation *by Kate Nowak*

Hello from my heart to yours,

The second Law of Stratospheric Success is the Law of Compensation:

Your income is determined by how many people you serve and how well you serve them.

The first law - the Law of Value - determines how valuable we are. It is about our potential for success. The second law is much more specific. It speaks of actualities. As is written in *The Go-Giver*, "Your compensation is directly proportional to how many lives you touch."

This law does a great deal to explain the somewhat disturbing disparity between what social workers, teachers, counselors, nurses, and many other service-oriented workers earn in comparison to professional athletes,

musicians, actors and the like. Our compensation is reflective to the number of lives we touch.

Please do not interpret this law as implying that those dedicated to social service are worth less. The law simply states that they are paid less because they impact comparatively fewer lives. The dedicated teacher, who may directly and indirectly touch five to ten thousand lives in the course of her career, even as vital and crucial to the world as her work may be, is going to earn considerably less than the superstar who, by virtue of extreme visibility alone, is capable of impacting millions in the course of one splash performance.

At first glance, this idea doesn't sit well with most people, but if you stop and consider it for a few moments, I think you'll come to realize, that whether it sits well or not, the second law does hold true: Our compensation really is reflective to the number of lives we touch.

And that's not a bad thing, because basically what it means is that you get to be the determining factor in your own success. As Nicole, one of the characters in *The Go-Giver* points out: "...it means that you get to determine your level of compensation - it's under your control. If you want more success, find a way to serve more people. It's that simple. It also means there are no limitations on what you can earn, because you can always find more people to serve. The Reverend Martin Luther King, Jr., once said, 'Everybody can be great because anybody can serve.' Another way to say that might be, 'Everybody can be successful because anybody can give.'"

You're included in that. You need only to find a way to assist the masses. And that is not nearly as difficult as one might think, especially now. For the next five days, as we discuss the second Law of Stratospheric Success in more detail, we'll be looking at examples and examining some of the ways that you can reach out and touch millions.

Today's Action Step:

1. Re-read your Prosperity Business Plan and your Ten Eleven Things Gratitude List.
2. Take a moment to stand firmly with one arm raised to the heavens, the fist clenched as firmly as if you were holding on to the hand of God. Now either mentally or vocally affirm: *"As God as my witness, I will be powerful today, I will be brave today, I will be strong today, I will be fearless today, I will prosper today. And I will live each moment of this day embracing my true nature and moving closer to becoming the person I am destined to be. For today and every day from this point forward this is my truth."*

Note: If possible write this affirmation on a card that will fit in your wallet or purse and carry it with you so you can refer whenever you feel doubts or fears arising. And each time you repeat this affirmation, say the words with as much feeling and emotion as you possibly can, spending at least one full minute imagining every aspect of your life as you want it to be.

3. Place today's allotment of money in your container and read the affirmation on the container three times. Expect to receive in return.
4. Bless those around you, including your fellow participants in this experiment. See those you bless prospering and surrounded by good. Then bless yourself and see the same. You may also want to continue blessing those on the blessing request list. Reading the responses will give you an opportunity to see for yourself.
